Mon, Tue, Wed, Fri 0700-1600 and Thurs 0800-1600.

Any travel (leisure or official) must be cleared by Public Health/Travel Medicine prior to coming to Immunizations. If on official travel, you must have a copy of orders.

- ◆ IPPD (TB skin tests) are given every day except Thursday or any Friday before a 3-day weekend.
- ◆ Yellow Fever shots are given on every Tuesday from 0900-0945.

FAMILY HEALTH and PEDIATRICS

Phone-In Refills to the Pharmacy: Refills called in by 1530 Monday-Friday will be available after 0900 the next duty day. Refills called in after 1530 on Friday and during the weekend will be ready after 0900 on Tuesday.

Civilian Prescriptions: The pharmacy will honor prescriptions written by civilian physicians provided the medication is stocked (on the formulary) at 579 MDG. Patients are encouraged to have their civilian physician write prescriptions authorizing substitution of generic drugs.
